Student Engagement: Beginning, Middle, and End of a Lesson

Class, Individual, and Group Spaces

- Beginning of a lesson
 - Lesson hook
 - Entry ticket / independent task (read & respond, watch & respond)
 - o SEL prompt
 - o Connect to previous lesson (activation)
- Middle of a lesson
 - Debate
 - Voting (using reactions)
 - Display/preserve brainstorming (whiteboard, stickynotes, audio/visual explanations)
 - o Student shares: table-group, pair, individual
- End of a lesson
 - o Self-reflection
 - o Comprehension check

Individual Space Ideas

- My Portfolio
- Goal Setting (record, document, progress, etc.)
- Subjects
- Units
- Personal Interest
- Project
- Competencies
- Subject-Specific Exploration (independent reading, current events, 'x subject' in everyday life, music practice, health & movement, etc.)
- Community Service
- Advisory

Project-Based Learning

- Ongoing documentation (progress checks, benchmarks, scaffolding)
- Ongoing reflection
- Group-work accountability
- Group-work collaboration
- Summative (display, reflect, next steps, celebrate, etc.)

Differentiation

- IEP Individual space (goal progression, coverage, modified/adapted tasks)
- Video and audio instructions
- Flexibility in student responses (written, audio, video, etc.)
- Co-teacher model

Family Engagement

- · Virtual celebration of learning
- Conferences (parent-teacher/student-led)
- Announcements
- New unit launch (communication of objectives, competencies, summative assessment)
- Share (special event, field trip, class activity)

Assessment

- 1:1 conferencing (Proficiency Report, Reporting Space)
- Retakes/Reassessments
- Self assessment
- Peer feedback
- Reporting Space (Visual report)
- Competencies/standards coverage
