COMMUNICATION

- Are there any spelling, grammar or punctuation errors that affect the communication in your peers' work?
- Can you offer suggestions to improve the structure of their work?
- Can you identify any biased language or assumptions that need to be altered in their work?
- Can you suggest any words or phrases that could be changed to make the communication more engaging and impactful?

THINKING

- How well has your peer followed the success criteria for the assignment?
- Can you help them identify any gaps in their reasoning or areas where more information is needed?
- Do you see any areas where your peer could benefit from considering different viewpoints or perspectives?
- Are there any strategies you can recommend to help your peer think more creatively and outside the box?

PERSONAL & SOCIAL

- Which parts of your peer's work do you feel really stand out and demonstrate strength?
- Which parts of the work should your peer practice more to get better at?
- Does the way the work is presented show that your peer put in a lot of effort and feels proud of it?
- Are there any actions, based on this work, that can be taken to help the community and the natural world in a positive and long-lasting way?
